Directions

Divide participants into pairs. Briefly interview each other on the items below, identifying individual *experiences and accomplishments* as they relate to the NCC project (i.e. conservation).

Reconvene as a full group to discuss the following questions: *Were there assets that you were surprised to unearth? Were there examples of “unusual” assets that were discovered? What are your group’s collective talents and experiences? What are your NCC resources?*
